### Available Projects:

- 1) Home of senior citizen who needs gutters cleaned out, removal of a fern palm, and fill in some cracks in the lanai and paint it.
- 2) Home of a senior citizen who needs gutters cleaned out and the ducts of a metal roof porch cleaned, some fill dirt to eliminate a hole in the yard, remove a dead bush and several light indoor “handyman” projects (sink stopper, “running” toilet, etc)
- 3) Home of senior citizen who needs general yard cleanup, including raking leaves, weeds, removing dead plants and cut back a sabal palm.
- 4) Home of senior citizen who needs a large pile of dirt removed from beside the house and spread over parts of the yard, and cut out some shrubs and plants.
- 5) A “Transitional Housing” location (provides shelter to women and children who are awaiting a permanent home). Needs: touch up existing paint in 3 rooms, paint baseboard in the hall, and trim a palm tree and an oak tree in the yard.
- 6) Friendzone at St. James needs volunteers to “shadow” and assist trained volunteers to work with a special needs child for the morning. This provides attention and care for the child and a respite for the parents.
- 7) Nursing home ministry: Volunteers will meet at church, make cards for nursing home residents, then deliver them and visit with the residents.
